Nursery & Preschool

Check-In/Drop off Guidelines

- Check-In/drop off begins at 9:30 am Please enter through the Education Building double doors (just south of the Sanctuary) and check your child in at the check in desk. A Preschool worker will escort your child to their classroom as parents are not allowed past this point to limit exposure to children & workers.
- Please have only **one parent** check-in/drop off child.
- Please **do not bring backpacks/diaper bags**. Please place the child's belongings in a gallon Ziplock bag with their name on it to enable us to wipe the bag down with a Clorox wipe.
- Your child will be required to have their temperature taken with a no touch thermometer (any child with a temperature of 100 degrees or higher will not be able to stay in the preschool area), and must be able to answer "no" to the four screening questions listed below.
- As per our Governor's mask mandate, masks are an option while in church services. If you feel more comfortable wearing a mask, we highly encourage that practice, especially when attending small classroom settings where risk of exposure is greater.
- Due to cold & allergy season, if you have a persistent cough please use a mask to put others at ease.
- All social distancing protocols will be followed.

Screening Questions

- Has your child had a fever of 100 degrees or more in the last 48 hours?
- Has your child exhibited symptoms of Covid in the last 48 hours (Please refer to the symptoms list below)?
- Has your child tested positive for Covid in the last 14 days?
- Has your child been exposed to anyone who has tested positive in the last 14 days?

Covid – 19 Symptoms

- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty with breathing
- Chills
- Muscle Pain
- Headache
- Sore Throat
- Loss of taste or smell
- Diarrhea
- Feverish or temp greater than 100 degrees

Classroom Practices

- All surfaces will be wiped down and sanitized frequently during class and after all children have left the department.
- All toys will be sanitized before given to another child (ex: when a child finishes playing with a toy, it will go in a basket that must be sanitized before returning to the community toy box). After all children are gone ALL toys will be wiped down with a disinfectant. We will also remove many of the toys from the rooms and rotate them each Sunday.
- Each child will have their own craft supplies (Ex. Crayons will be placed in a small Ziplock bag with the child's name on it so only that child will be handling that group of crayons).
- If snacks are given, they will be individual packages.

Pick-Up Guidelines

- One parent or guardian will pick-up child following service at the desk. Please do not pass the check-in station; your child will be escorted to you at the check-in desk.
- Please have the child's security tag ready to submit to the checkout attendant.
- After each event the preschool and nursery area will be sanitized.
