Screening Questions

- Have you had a fever of 100 degrees or more in the last 48 hours?
- Have you exhibited symptoms of Covid in the last 48 hours (Please refer to the symptoms list below)?
- Have you had tested positive for Covid in the last 14 days?
- Have you had been exposed to anyone who has tested positive in the last 14 days?

Covid – 19 Symptoms

- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty with breathing
- Chills
- Muscle Pain
- Headache
- Sore Throat
- Loss of taste or smell
- Diarrhea
- Feverish or temp greater than 100 degrees

Recommendations

- Hand sanitization stations will be in place and a requirement for every person joining us.
- As per our Governor's mask mandate, masks are an option while in church services. If you feel more comfortable wearing a mask, we highly encourage that practice, especially when attending small classroom settings where risk of exposure is greater.
- Due to cold & allergy season, if you have a persistent cough please use a mask to put others at ease.
